HOW TO FILL OUT THE FORM?

To successfully report an incident and/or damage: **1.** Go to:

www.projectsunflowers.org

2. Click on the red button.

SHARE INFORMATION

3. Complete the request to contact a Project Sunflowers volunteer.

4. A volunteer will contact you within 3 days. The volunteer will provide you with an activation link to the form. The activation link is valid for 3 days, which means that you should log in to the form during this time. You can complete the form yourself or ask a volunteer to help you complete it for free.

Until the form is submitted, you can edit it as many times as you like.

5. You send the form and get the confirmation of it.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

Project Sunflowers is an international project, created by prominent lawyers, including Ukrainian ones, in response to the need to collect information about evidence of crimes committed in Ukraine and their victims.

The information collected will create a database that will then be made available to prosecutors investigating crimes committed in Ukraine, including the Office of the Prosecutor at the International Criminal Court in The Hague, and subsequently to the International Criminal Court (as well as to other international tribunals, including the Court of Aggression or the Hybrid Tribunal, if established) and the national courts of the countries that will hear cases for these crimes, including Ukrainian courts. Information about the affected persons will also be provided to international and national institutions that will implement reparation programmes for victims of the war in Ukraine.

Remember that...

the security of your data is our priority! For this reason, no one except the competent authorities will have access to your data and the extent of the information you have provided to us.

APPLICATION FORM

The more information about evidence of crimes, the better the chance of **convicting the perpetrators!**

If you have information about incidents and evidence of crimes committed in Ukraine since 24 February 2022 and/or have suffered harm as a result of such crimes, please share it with us. The form by which the Project Sunflowers collects such information:

• it is completed voluntarily and at a convenient time (you decide for yourself if and when you do so)

• it can be amended at any time and you can even withdraw your consent to pass such information on to the competent authorities (you decide which information you want to pass on and to what extent)

• you can complete it online only (which reduces the risk of it being physically destroyed)

• you can fill it in yourself (we have made sure to include interactive tools in the form) or contact our volunteer to help you fill it in for free (our volunteers are trained to do this; your data will not be disclosed to anyone)

• you can supplement the information with photos and videos (this will free up space on your phone or computer)

Remember that sending in a completed form does not mean that you will be a witness in future proceedings. The authority to whom the information is submitted will decide who will appear in such a role before the court.

Information about damages will speed up the preparation of reparation programmes for victims of the war in Ukraine. The more information about the type and extent of damages, the better the chance to optimise reparation programmes!
